- **Ebooks.cpm.org (Sign in with your armadanow account)**
 - **Homework Help**
 - Students can still work through home practice problems and be able to check the solutions to most of the HP problems.
 - This is available on the ebook by clicking on the “homework help” link next to each home practice problem.
 - **Parent Guide with Extra Practice**
 - This gives students the opportunity to review the steps necessary to solve problems, which is then followed by practice problems and answers.

 - Khan Academy is a great resource if you would like to see a problem worked out step by step and hear an explanation for each step. Khan Academy is very up-to-date with their problem solving strategies to match the steps used by CPM.

 - iXL is a great tool that gives immediate feedback for problems. If a student gets an answer incorrect, iXL shows the student the steps necessary to arrive at the correct answer. (Please do not just click past this part if you get an answer incorrect as you may continue to make the same mistake.)
